### **Health & Safety Executive**

HSE is warning the Waste and Recycling Industry to renew efforts to improve worker safety, following a spate of deaths over the summer. Nine lives were lost in separate incidents in just 12 weeks between June 2012 and September 2012. Half of the deaths occurred in skip hire and waste transfer prerruses.

Heather Bryant, HSE's Operations Director and lead for HSE's waste and recycling strategy unit, said "These fatal accidents should be a stark reminder for all employers in this section to check their controls on the use of vehicles and equipment to make sure that staff are properly trained and supervised".

"We will not hesitate to take action if we find evidence that lives are being put at risk. There is no room for complacency in this sector - close attention must be given to equipment like compactors and skip vehicles."
